It is notified for information of all concerned that as approved by the Cabinet in its meeting held on the 16/1/2026, Community-Integrated Skill Learning (CISL) shall be introduced in class X from the academic session 2027-2028. The Objectives of CISL are as follows:


- Mainstream vocational, skill-based, sports, arts and community-linked learning into school education.
- Restore dignity of labour and value family and community occupations
- Promote experiential, competency- based learning
- Strengthen family-school-community partnerships
- Develop work ethics, responsibility, and life skills among students.

Community-Integrated Skill Learning (CISL) shall carry 50% of the total assessment weightage of Health and Physical Education, with the remaining 50% continuing to be assessed through the prescribed curriculum.
