It is notified for information of all concerned that the Board in its meeting held on the 20th April, 2018 vide Agenda No.5 has decided that with the introduction of the New Course of studies at Class IX & X, the following categories of students shall appear as OLD COURSE CANDIDATES in the ensuing SSLC Examination.

- (i) Non Regular: - Those who failed in the SSLC Examination, 2018 or earlier Examination.
- (ii) Compartmental Candidates.
- (iii) Improvement Candidates.
- (iv) Private Candidates appearing for 100 marks.

These candidates will be given two (2) chances to clear the Old Course of Studies i.e., in the 2019 and 2020 SSLC Examinations. After the two chances, the unsuccessful candidates will have to be re-admitted and appear the SSLC Examination as regular candidates in the New Courses of Studies.
